William Greer Architectural Conservation and Craftsmanship – honours building owners for excellence in the restoration or adaptive reuse of a heritage building (projects of all sizes will be considered).

Book – for a non-fiction book about Toronto's archaeological, built, cultural or natural heritage, published in 2012.

Short Publication – celebrates excellent print and online articles and booklets about Toronto's history published in 2012.

Media – recognizes production projects such as films, videos and websites.

Community Heritage Award – a cash prize awarded to volunteer-based organizations for a significant activity that promotes or protects Toronto's heritage.
